Tour the tide pools teeming with fascinating marine life. Moderate.

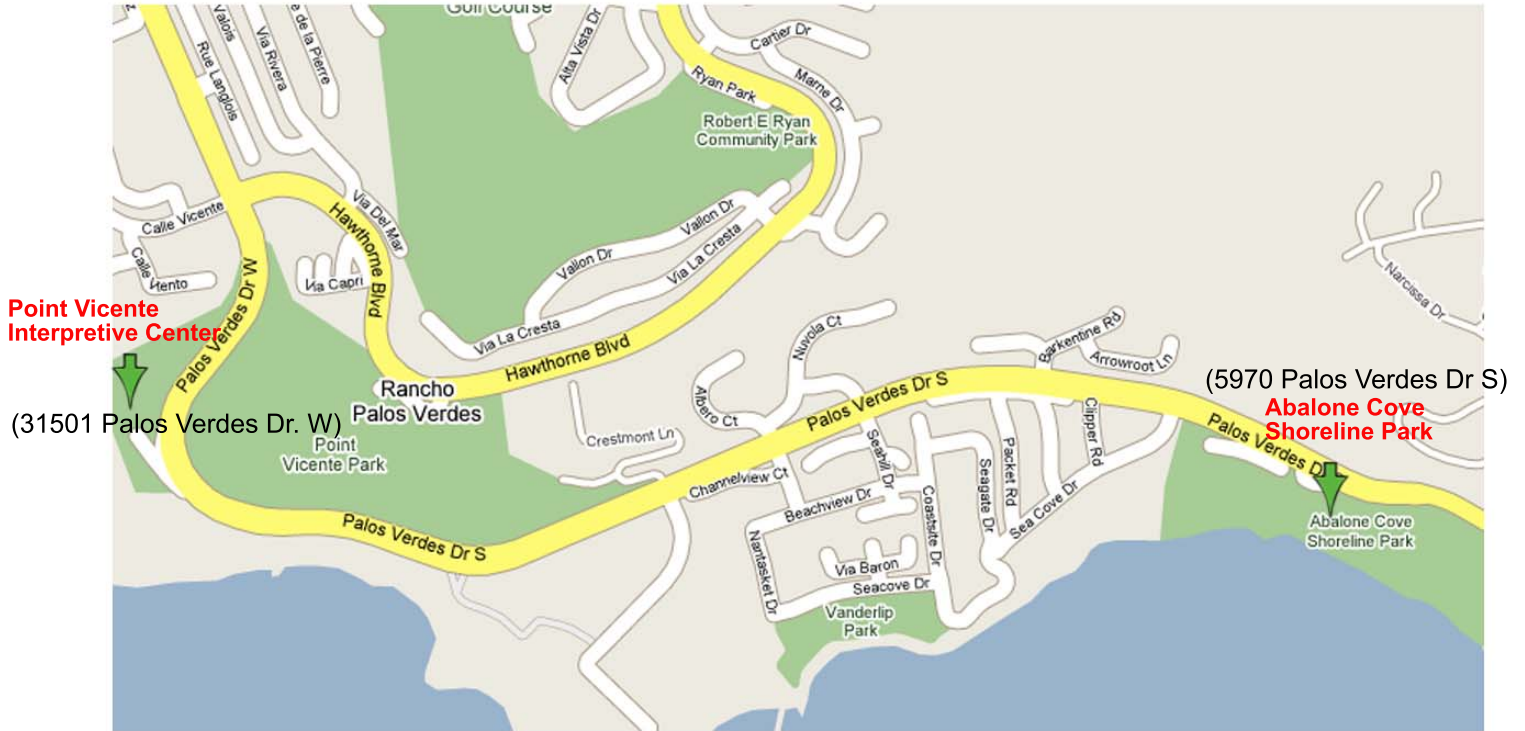
